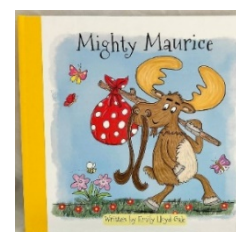


Netball – District Tournament

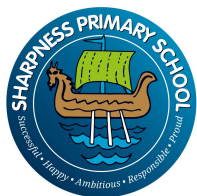
Children in Need Day – 14th November

Jupiter Class – Meet The Brain

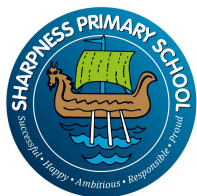
The children will explore the Wellbeing Wheel and have discussions about its five ways to emotional good health. They will also consider how to ensure that online behaviour is healthy and balanced.

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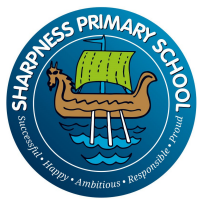

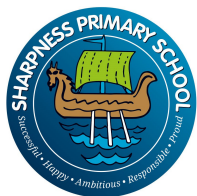
